Prerequisites for entering Practitioner Training:

Complete Application to AHSC—Submitted by one month prior to Prac I start

Successful completion of the following classes:

- Foundations of Science of Mind – 36 credit Hours
- Self Mastery – 30 Credit Hours
- Roots of Science of Mind – 30 credit hours
- Spiritual Practices – 30 credit hours

Summary of Classes for Professional Practitioner Training:

Practitioner Year I – Developing A Practitioner Consciousness

30 Weekly Sessions beginning September 2020 (7:00 - 10:00 pm)

3 Ten Week Terms - \$300 each term

Practitioner Year II – Learning Skills of a Licensed Practitioner

30 Weekly Sessions beginning October, 2021

10 Week, 13 Week, and 8 Week Terms - \$300 each term

- Term 1 – The Life of the Professional Practitioner
- Term 2 – Spiritual Healing and Responsibilities
- Term 3 – The Professional Practitioner in the World

Texts Required For Practitioner II

Additional requirement:

One session per term with a Licensed Professional Religious Science Practitioner (6 sessions over the course of two year studies). Practitioner may any licensed, Religious Science Practitioner (price to be mutually negotiated).

Financial Responsibility:

Tuition paid in full by the end of each term. Any refunds pro-rated in agreement with the instructor and the AHSC Stewardship Core.

Absences:

100% attendance required. The student may collaborate with the instructors for “make up” of missed classes.

Homework, Quizzes & Projects:

- Homework and projects must all be submitted to the instructor on the designated due date.
- Quizzes must be taken on the same day with all other practitioner students.
- Projects must be completed as scheduled.

Credit Hours Required by Emerson Theological for Certification:

- Foundations + Self Mastery + Roots + Spiritual Practices - 126 credit Hours
- Practitioner Training Year One & Two - 180 credit Hours
- Internship – 9 Credit Hours – 3 monthly meetings of 3 hours each
- Electives (Listed Below) – 45 credit hours
- TOTAL credits required for Certification: 360 hours

Electives (minimum of 45 total hours required from the classes below):

- Radical Forgiveness – 30 credit Hours
- Visioning – 18 credit hours
- The Essential Ernest Homes – 30 credit hours (previously 18 hours).
- Prosperity – 18 Credit Hours
- Mysticism - 30 Credit Hours
(Others TBA)

These classes will be offered before the end of the Internship so that you will have all the necessary credits required.

After Completion of Practitioner 2:

- Written examination for Practitioner Credential with Emerson (no fee).
- Professional Practitioner Credential application fee with Emerson \$150.
- Internship: three months (no fee).
- Oral Panel for Practitioner Credential (after Internship-no fee).

Practitioner Internship Requirements After Completion of Written Exam: (no fee)

- One 3 hour Practice Session for the Oral Exams. 3 Credit hours
- Three 2 hour client practice sessions – 6 Credit hours.
- Completion of Practitioner Personal Manual.
- Platform duty and Ministry of Prayer brief sessions following service with coaching.
- Completion of 5 case histories and 5 accompanying demonstration letters for submission to Emerson Practitioner Credentials.
- Instructor Assistance with Application to Emerson Theological.
- One on one coaching when appropriate or requested.
